Building bridges between in, before, after, and out of school (including summer).

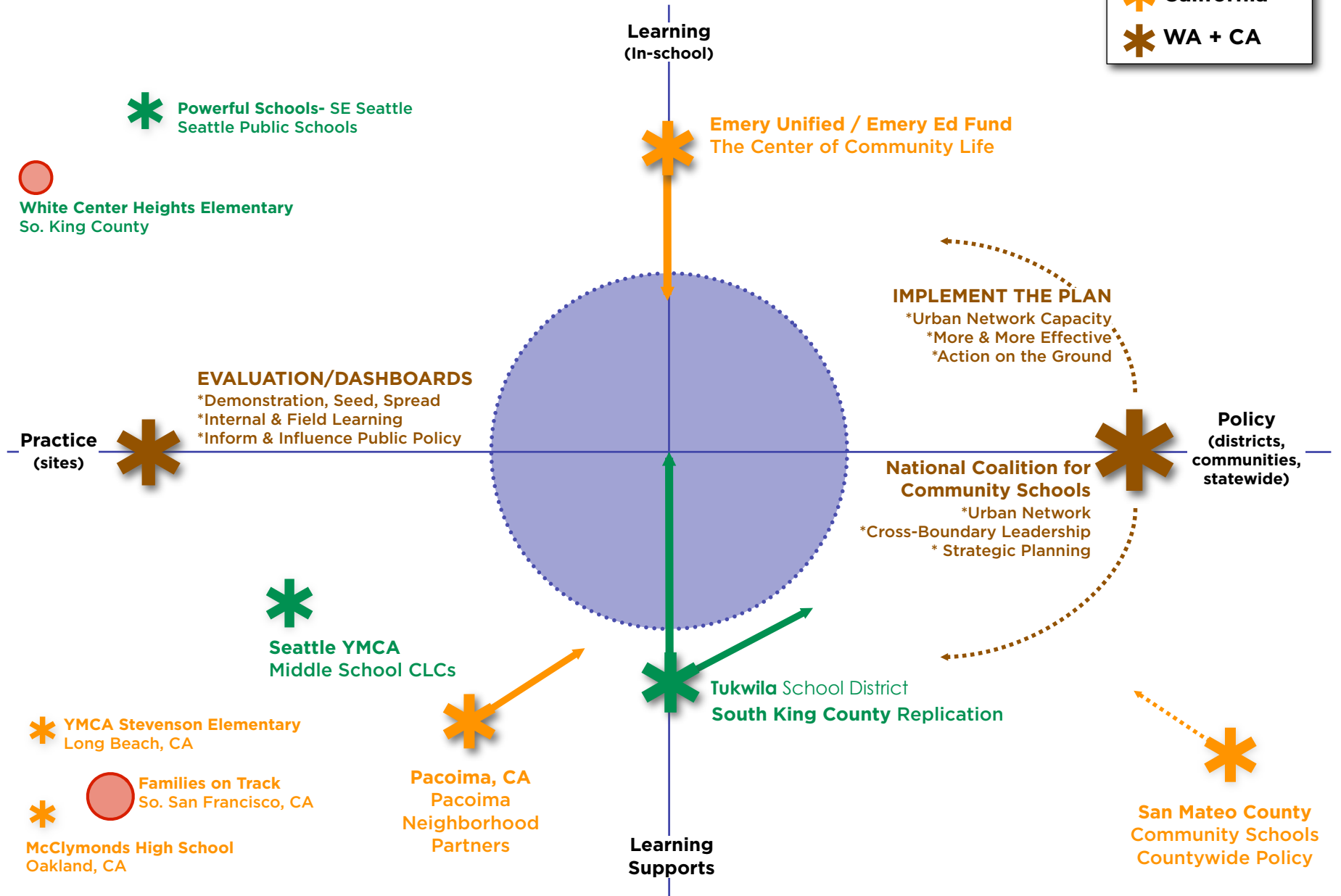
Education is an integral, yet single, non-isolated dimension of a young person's development.

Great communities do not exist without great schools.

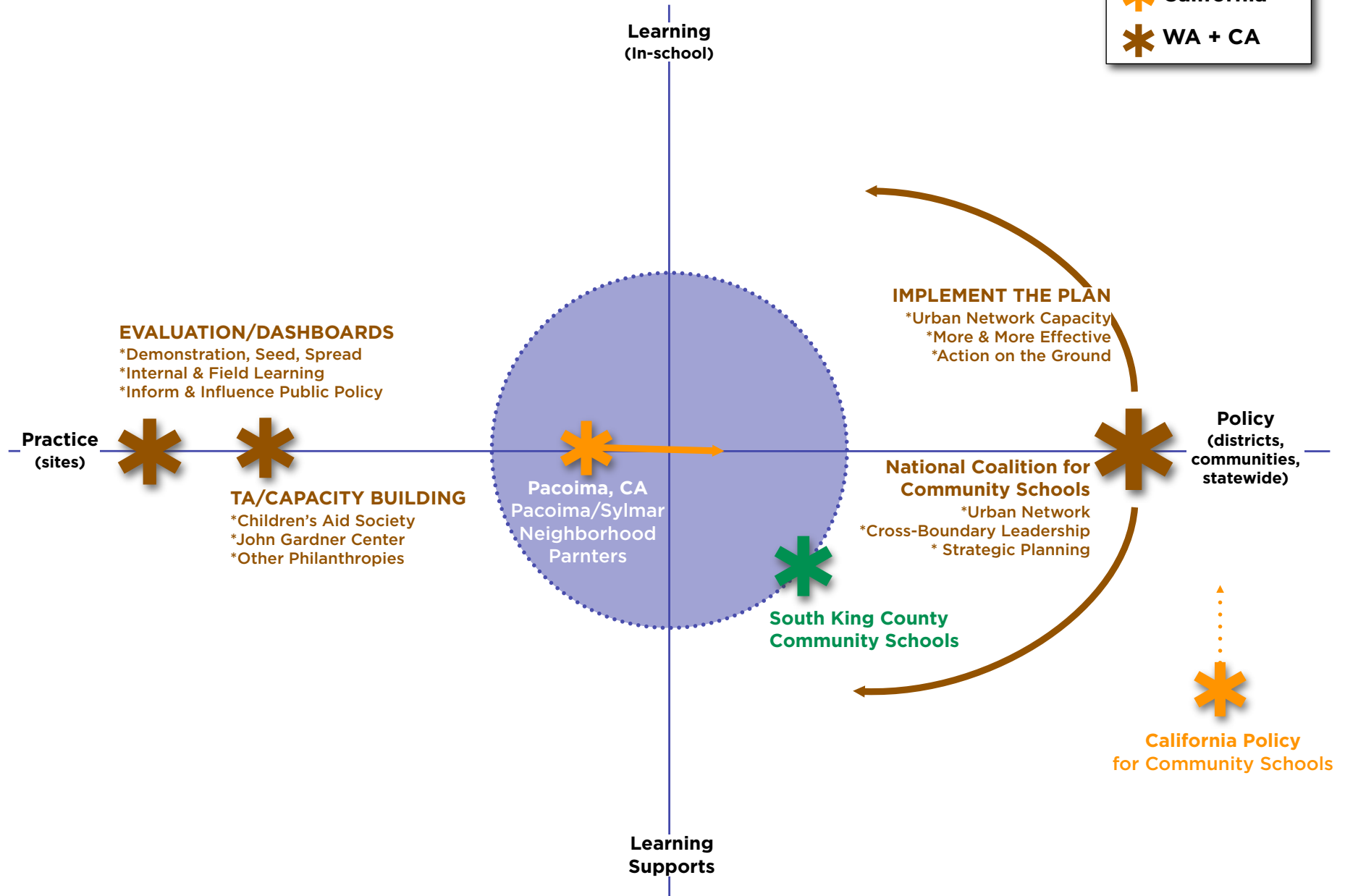

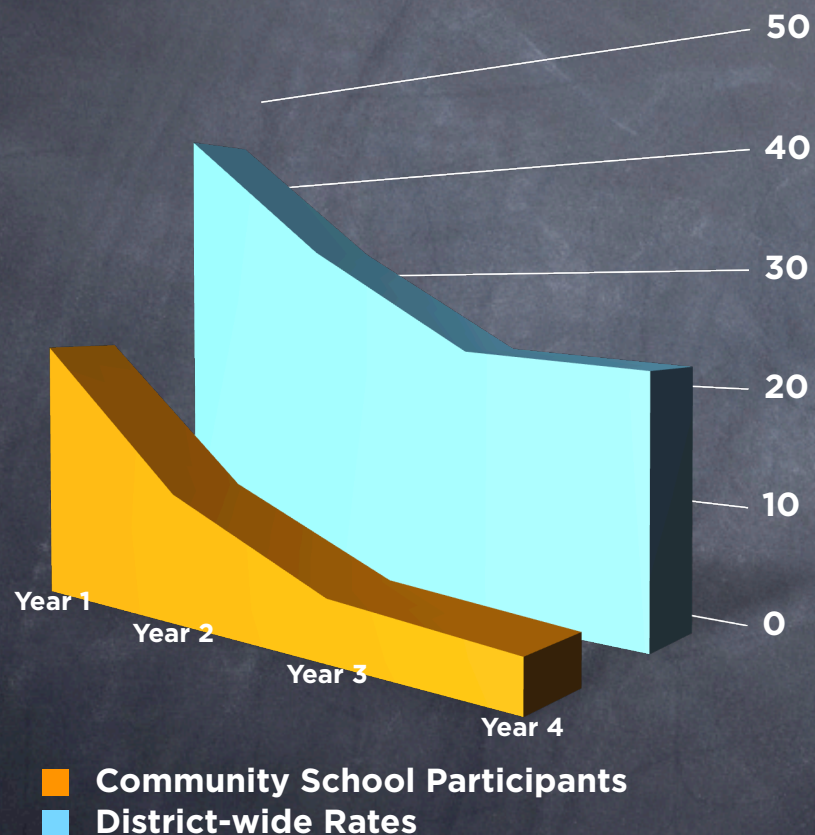

Tukwila Mobility Rates (%)



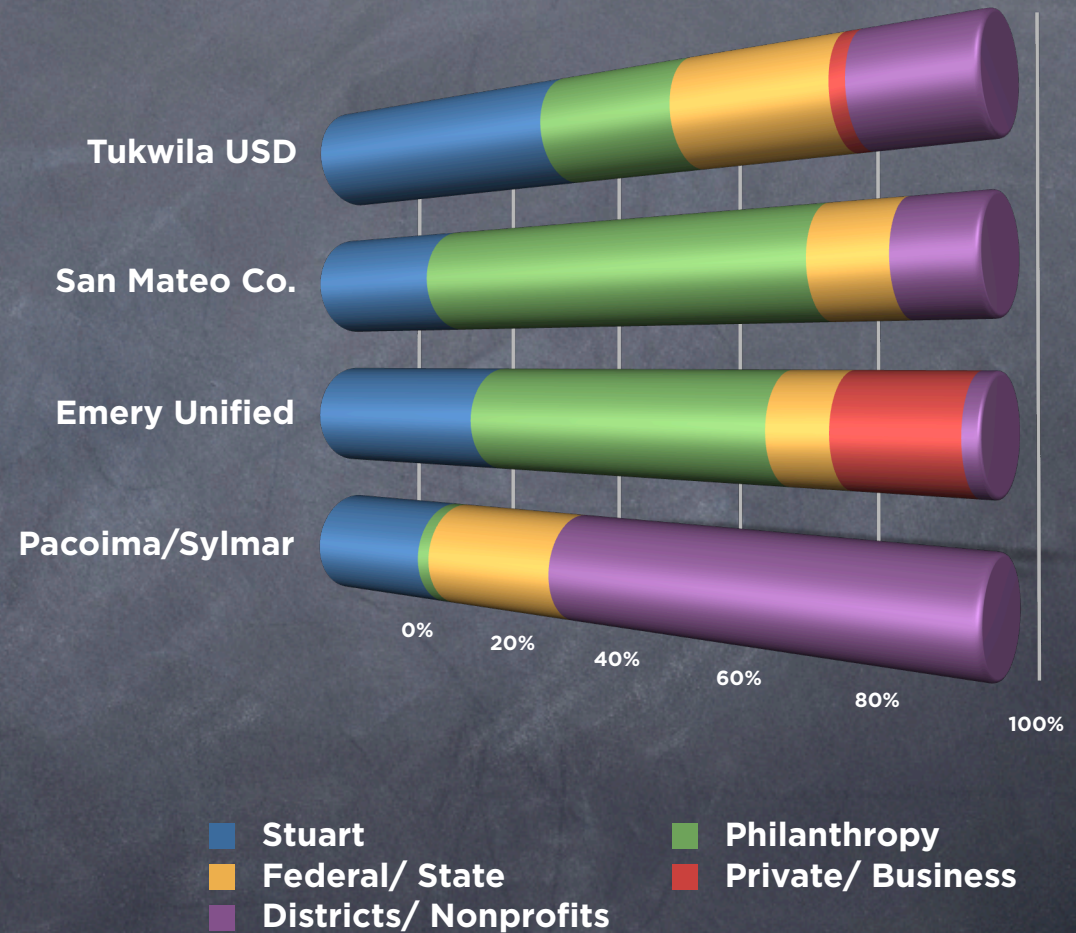

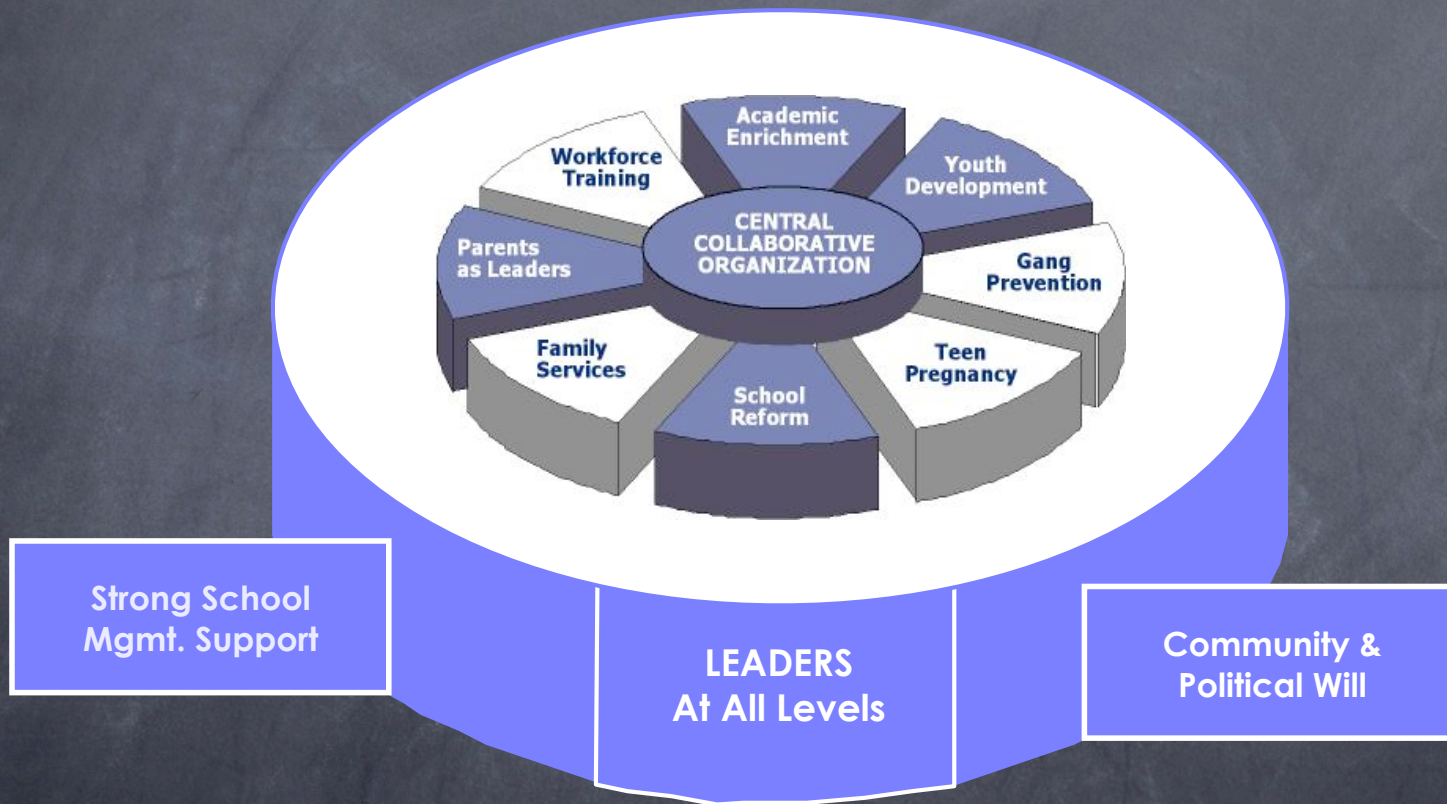
